Legal powers for conducting Raid

under IFA 1927

u/s 72 (1) c- power to issue search warrant under the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898

u/s 52 -seizure of property liable to confiscation

Provisions in CrPC-

u/s 94(1): Search of place suspected to contain stolen property, forged documents, etc.

Receipt of seized articles -notice (Section- 51 CrPc)

Legal powers contd....

• under WPA 1972:

```
u/s 50(1)(b): power of entry, search (authorised/ any Forest officer)
```

u/s 50(1)(c): seize & arrest without warrant u/s 50(8):issue search warrant- not below rank of ACF

Intelligence gathering

- Reliable source
- Using secret service fund
- Offence database of division
- Inter division coordination and Inter department coordination especially with Police
- Goodwill with forest fringe villagers
- Tiger cell meetings
- Mobile squads/flying squads/vigilance team regular meetings

Staff in action









Planning for Raid

- Who will lead the team?
- Secrecy of information and Reliability of source
- Timing of raid
- Manpower planning- team members selection
- Police coordination if needed
- Independent witness
- Protective gears-anticipation of attack
- Videography
- Usage of Drones-needed? Procedural requirements-permission in flying residential areas

Planning contd:

- Vehicles & labourers to recover the seized materials
- Closing off check posts
- Leakage prevention- switching off mobile phones ?/using different vehicles/ surprise routes
- Interstate coordination- border divisions
- Use of Cybercells Tracing

Precaution & Preparedness

- Keeping search warrant
- (Form no 10 –warrant to search after information of a particular offence {sec-93 CrPC}, Form no 11- warrant to search suspected place of deposit {sec-94 CrPC},)
- Preventing entry {sec-186 IPC : Obstructing public servant in discharge of public functions}
- Polite language
- Handling mob of villagers
- Entering house sufficient time since female members (section- 47(2) Cr.Pc)
- Lady staff in team
- Allegations of Harassment and Atrocities

Precaution & preparedness

- Attack on staff/vehicles
- Backup force
- Deterrent measures
- Alternate video recordings
- Aware of routes (Entry and exit)
- Interference in carrying out raids
- Dealing with life threats and staff safety

Offence registration

- Seizure of forest produce/wildlife articles
- Booking of Prosecution offence report
- Sealing of sawmills no valid license/requisite registers
- Panchanama (witness statement)
- Seizure memo/seizure panchnama
- videography/photography
- Seizing mobile phones

Offence registration contd..

- Measuring and recording of seized materials
- Time consuming process
- Transfer to Depot
- Field Situations not always favorable to carryout above
- Source of forest produce- further leads during interrogation
- Press note

Went for night raid at kumarapara village & seized 5 no cycles along with sawn timber and returned back around 3:30 A.M the following day.	97 km	
	20/05/2014	Office work followed by morning patrolling. Proceeded to DFO office, Cooch behar .went on night patrolling and seized 3 no. of cycles with sawn timber from kumarapara village .	137 km	
	21/05/2014	Office work and morning patrolling. Went along with AWLW for inspection of 13 th FC works in various beats under the range. Office work followed by night patrolling.	90 km	

Rewarding the informers

- u/s 76 IFA Additional power to make rules:
- 76 (b) regulate the rewards to be paid to officers and informers out of the proceeds of fines and confiscation under this act
- u/s 60 WLPA:
- 60 A Reward to Persons
- 60-B Reward by State Govt (CWLW may empowered not exceeding Rs 10,000)
